Release Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Agreement

As a condition of participating in the Ranch Rodeo produced by South Texas Rodeo Cowgirl's (herein-after referred to as STRRC), each contestant or participant agrees, that the STRRC, Arena Crew and any volunteers or workers working on behalf of the STRRC is not responsible for any injury to the contestant or damage or theft to property belonging to or used by the contestant involved in the rodeo. Each contestant agrees to be responsible for all damages, theft or injuries that occur to the contestant or any property or animal owned or used by the contestant and to hold harmless the STRRC for such injuries or damages. The Contestant acknowledges that participating in the STRRC Rodeo involves significant danger and risk of injury or death to person and personal livestock and on behalf of contestant's personal representative, heirs, spouse, and next of kin, agrees and understands, as a condition of participating in the Rodeo, to hold harmless the STRRC and any animal owned or used by the contestant and agrees to personally assume all responsibility for any and all injuries or damages that may occur as a result of participating in the event.

The contestant further agrees that any expenses or attorney fees incurred by the STRRC for a breach of this agreement shall be paid by the contestant. The contestant voluntarily agrees to all risks associated with participating in the Rodeo and again waives all liability of the STRRC and agrees to hold harmless the STRRC and all afore mentioned parties connected with the Rodeo for all injuries to the contestant's person or property owned or used by the contestant. The contestant agrees that any cause of action arising from participation in the Rodeo or any cause of action pertaining to this agreement shall be filed in the County and State in which the parties entered into it. Contestants understand and agree that if they pull out of the Ranch Rodeo 10 days of ranch rodeo, they will forfeit their entry fees. Pulling out before that is acceptable.
